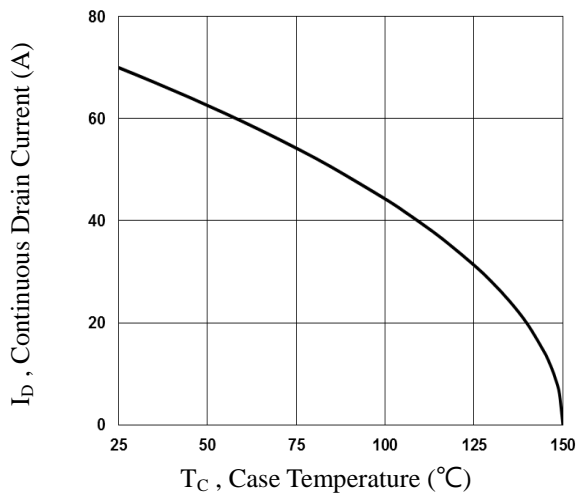

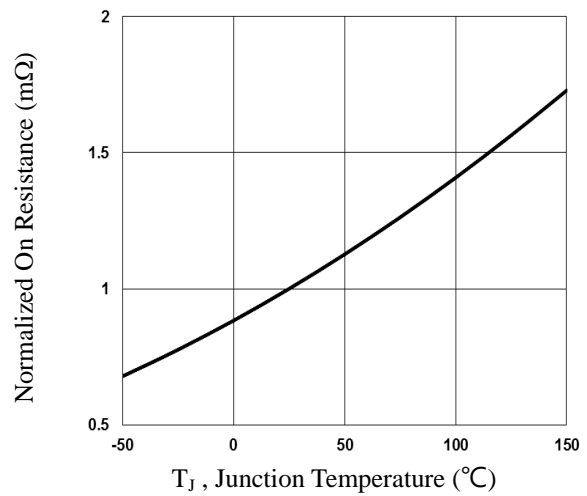

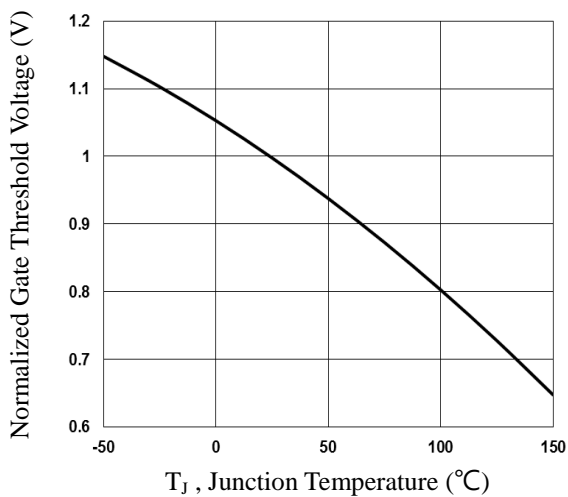

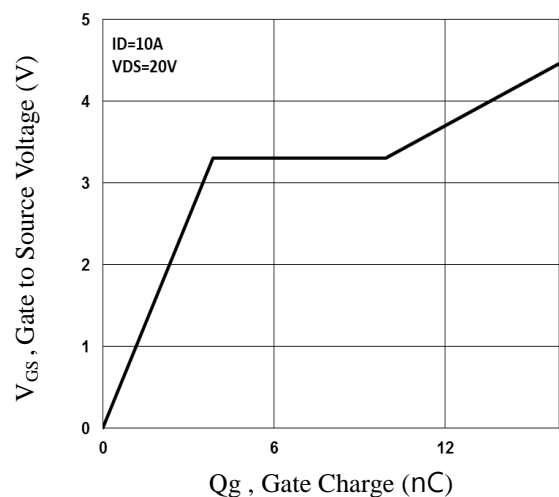
**Fig.1 Continuous Drain Current vs.  $T_C$**



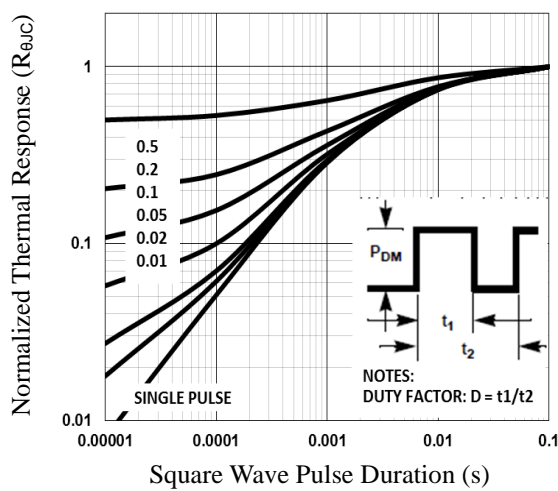
**Fig.2 Normalized  $R_{DS(on)}$  vs.  $T_J$**



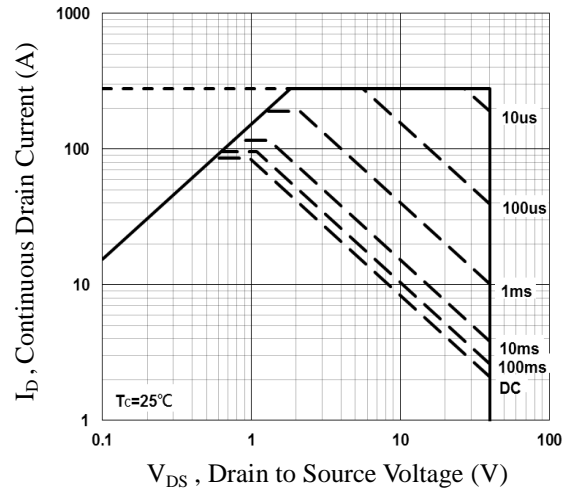
**Fig.3 Normalized  $V_{th}$  vs.  $T_J$**



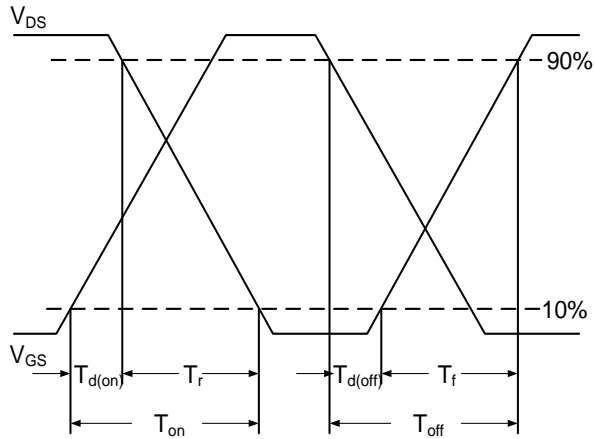
**Fig.4 Gate Charge Waveform**



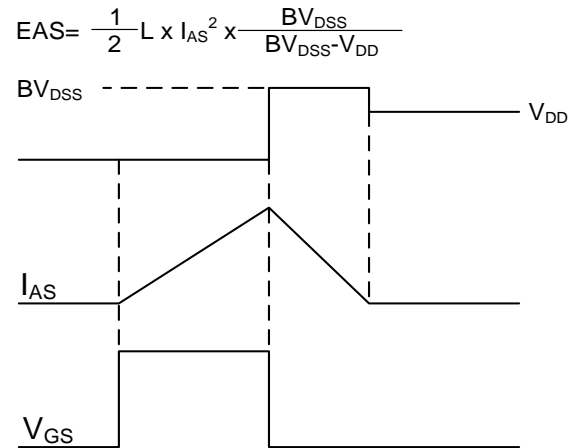
**Fig.5 Normalized Transient Impedance**



**Fig.6 Maximum Safe Operation Area**

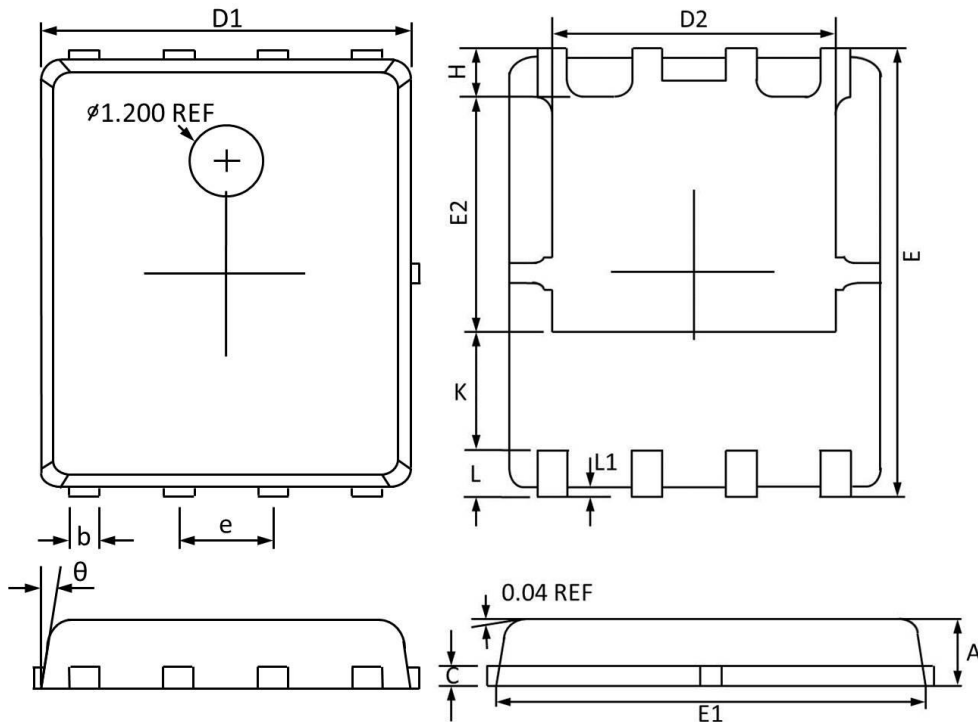


**Fig.7 Switching Time Waveform**
